1. All Star has been canceled for Spring 2021
2. Classical is being held on April 24, 2021 at Calvary Lutheran.

It will be run the same way that Baroque, 2020 was run: students will come individually to Calvary, their performance will be taped for an adjudicator, they will have a Covid sensitive space to take the theory test.

Due to Covid there will be no Honors recital so it is not a requirement for competitive status.

The amount of scholarships will depend on the number of competitive entries. This will be decided after entries are received.

Detailed instructions will be sent to teachers after scheduling. They will include the updated bowing procedure.

Entry forms are on the website. They are due on April 9 to Maggie Charnon. Teachers are reminded that the essay question and the entry fee must accompany the entry form.

Teachers must be available to work on the day of the festival.

Teachers are reminded that they may enter students as noncompetitive. With this status students are not required to memorize. They may enter in any level. Theory, technique and a second contrasting piece are optional.

Results will be announced about 2 weeks after the festival.
