Composer: Maurice Ravel. French.

Fact: One of the first composers to make recordings

Composition: Gaspard de la Nuit

## **Contemporary Period**

1900-present

Features: tone clusters, polychords, aleatoric composition, prepared piano, electronic and computer influenced composition and performance, pointillism

Composer: John Cage, American

Fact: Pioneer in the avant-garde movement

Composition: Silence
