cadences in tonic.

Coda: Optional ending section

2<sup>nd</sup> Mvt: Usually a slow movement with a more lyrical melody. Usually in AB or ABA form but may also be through composed.

3<sup>rd</sup> Mvt: Usually fast and often in Rondo Form.

## 20th Century Idioms

**Bitonality:** Music written simultaneously in two keys (tonal centers) Such as right hand in D and left hand in B

Atonality: Music without a key or tonal center

12-tone: Dodecaphonic. Music based on tone rows consisting of all 12 tones without repetition. Designed to break down conventional harmony and melodic traditions.Serialism: An extension of the 12-tone concept but includes the serialization of other elements of composition such as dynamics and rhythm.
