

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE:

CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Any student of a current forum member is eligible.
2. Students need to fill out an application form and return it to the scholarship chairman by the due date which is the first Friday of May.
3. Up to \$750 may be given out in camp scholarships in any year.
4. The amount given to any individual shall be based of the cost of the camp.
 - a. Camps costing up to \$100 – scholarship will be no more than \$25.00
 - b. Camps costing \$101 - \$250 – scholarship will be no more than \$75.00
 - c. Camps costing \$251 - \$499 – scholarship will be no more than \$125.00
 - d. Camps costing \$500 - \$999 – scholarship will be no more than \$150.00
 - e. Camps costing \$1000 - ??? – scholarship will be no more than \$175.00

COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Any student of a current member is eligible.
 - a. Music major – Up to \$500 will be awarded to individuals who enroll as a music major with piano emphasis. An additional \$500 will be given for their 2nd year of study if still a music major with piano emphasis. (see #6 below).
 - b. Music minor – a onetime award of \$250 will be given to those who enroll as a music minor with piano emphasis.
2. Students need to fill out an application form and return it to the scholarship chairman by the due date which is the first Friday of May.
3. \$1500 in college scholarships may be awarded each year.
4. The scholarship committee working with the treasurer will decide each year how much of the \$1500 will be awarded. Each applicant that is eligible may receive up to a \$500 scholarship for their 1st year of study.
5. The students will be judged on participation and rank in the forum's festivals, participation and rating in the WSMA festivals, grade point average, any other piano achievements, and a letter of recommendation by the piano teacher.
6. Any scholarship recipient may apply for up to an additional \$500 for their 2nd year of college study. They must still be a music major with a piano emphasis and be a fulltime student with a 3.00 grade point average. This information and request for the additional \$500 should be made to the scholarship chairman by the June 15 after their Freshman year.

MEMBER SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship committee recommends that individual members not be given any money to attend various workshops or clinics.

1. It is felt that teachers attending these workshops or clinics can take a tax write off for their expenses.
2. It is suggested that we continue to bring in good clinicians so that all teachers would benefit with their knowledge.
