Festival Descriptions

Baroque Festival

- 1. Held annually in late fall.
- 2. Dedicated to the study and performance of works from the Baroque Era (1600-1750).
- 3. Students compete in five levels for scholarships and presentation at an Honors Recital.
- 4. Requirements for competition: Audition with a memorized selection from the NEWPTF Baroque Repertoire List. Placement in a level is subject to age and ability level. See the website for the list and the levels. Students may participate as competitive or non-competitive. See below for details.

All Star Festival

- Held annually in Spring
- 2. Non-competitive festival
- Students aim for their personal best in the choice of one or more of these events: solo
 performance, duet and ensemble performance, music fair, composition, theory/history
 knowledge exam, "Technique Challenge 88". Details and rules for these events are below.

General Rules and Procedures for All Festivals (Specific rules are below)

1. Eligibility

Members: Teachers must be currently enrolled as members of NEWPTF. Their students will receive a member discount for entry and may receive awards, scholarships and presentation on Honors Recitals.

Non-members: Students of non-member teachers are welcome to participate. If they are winners, they are eligible for placement and presentation on the Honors Recital but will not receive awards or scholarships.
